Our Sunday School Program

Sunday School for children takes place in our Children's Building at two different times on Sunday mornings. At 10 a.m. we offer classes for age 3 through fifth grade. We all gather in the Great Room to greet each other and sing before splitting into age-specific classes for the day's topic. At 11:15 a.m. we offer a combined class for all elementary school-age children in Room C203 and nursery care for preschoolers in Room C109.

Theology Pub

Parents: Join us for Theology Pub the first Sunday of every month. Your kiddos are welcome too. This is an informal, social gathering for fellowship and friendly conversation about living our faith. Led by Pastor Katy, we meet at Waterloo Ice House 9600 Escarpment Blvd., from 5-7 p.m. Church employees will offer on-site child care, so your child(ren) can play while we talk!

Kids Choir

The music program has a new sound for children. Sunday mornings offer a full hour of music for second through fifth graders with Ms. Kati Cox in the Great Room of the Children's Building. Children can either attend the 8:45 a.m. worship service and leave with Ms. Jenny after Children's Time or go directly to the Great Room at 9 a.m. First graders and younger will be visited by Ms. Kati during the 10 a.m. Sunday School classes for music time.

Nursery and Child Care Ministries

We have bright, clean, inviting nursery rooms in the Children's Building with loving child care providers who are trained in first aid and CPR. We offer nursery care on Sunday mornings during all worship services, and nursery/child care for other church events when it has been prearranged.
