All youth need a caring home to reach their full potential. **The Refuge for DMST™** (Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking) developed and operates **The Refuge Ranch**, a long-term, residential, therapeutic community for girls, minors through age 19, who have been rescued out of sex trafficking. House Moms live alongside survivors, providing guidance, love, and stability as they heal from the trauma they've endured. You can help survivors directly by creating this sense of family for girls in need.

All applicants must:

- be 21 years or older;
- be able to remain regulated in the face of triggered trauma and what may appear to be an unwillingness to engage;
- have the capacity to practice under a trauma-informed framework;
- have a stable, kind and creative personality; and
- have a reliable vehicle.

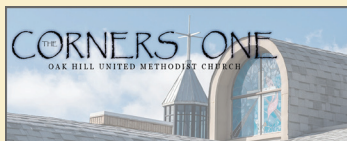
