



VOLUNTEER IN ONE OF OUR HOMELESS MINISTRIES

COLD WEATHER SHELTER - On freeze nights, the alliance operates a cold weather shelter in our Fellowship Hall for people experiencing homelessness and forced to camp in the southern and southwestern parts of town. We run this outreach initiative in partnership with The Other Ones Foundation.

COMPASS NETWORK - Compass Network Oak Hill is designed to permit area churches that are members of the Oak Hill Community Alliance an opportunity to expand relationship building and service to neighbors experiencing homelessness. The program, an outreach ministry led by Sunrise Church, offers weekly, free meals to homeless guests from 1-3 p.m. each Sunday at the intersection of William Cannon and Hwy 290 W. Participating churches provide a meal, clothing, hygiene kits, and relationship building to guests. In addition, agencies that serve the homeless, including Sunrise Church and The Other Ones Foundation, have agreed to be available to help guests enter or navigate the process toward housing.
